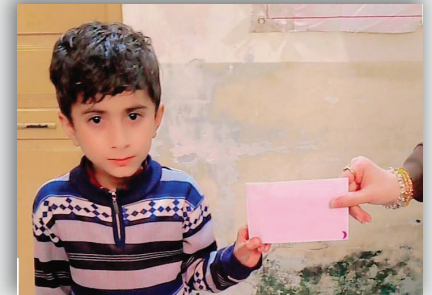
### Parent-Teacher Meeting (PTM) – Grade 8 & Package C (2025–2026)
